### Claus on culture

Prince Claus was a German married to the Dutch queen Beatrix and as such was able to see the Dutch with German eyes and vice versa. He had a personal intercultural experience which influenced his thinking about development cooperation. Jan Pronk in his book Willens en wetens bring this again to our attention. Claus often said: 'on ne developpe pas, on se developpe', referring to the fact that people take their own learning

and development processes at hand, which you can stimulate but not orchestrate or control. He also felt that there needs to be more attention for the cultural side of the development cooperation (or international cooperation). "Rethinking development means first and foremost curbing ethnocentrism". "The poly-cultural nature of the world we live in is indeed something to be treasured and kept alive." He thinks that "it is recognised that there is a cultural dimension to development, but it is at the same time regarded as a nuisance and solutions are sought by just adding a dash of culture to our development efforts which otherwise remain valid as before. Such a conception is rooted in the economically minded cultures. Economic achievements are still at the top of their scale of values." Though it is written 10 years ago, I wonder how much things have really changed in this regard and how much the development sector has learned about the cultural elements at play in development cooperation. PS. somehow it feels weird not to write about the elections in the Netherlands, you see how much blogging is somehow associated with citizens journalism.

### **Interview With A Former Peace Corps Volunteer In Kazakhstan: Part 2**

For Bob (who, incidentally, is NOT featured in this picture, at least I don't think so), the best part of the two years as a whole was being part of a meaningful cultural exchange - he became ensconced in the local culture and felt he could offer locals a view of American culture and way of life in return. The challenges sound overwhelming, and Bob points out the importance of keeping things in perspective. In his experience, those who went with "save the world" motives ended up being the most disillusioned. You have to be able to laugh at problems and, it seems, keep functioning when the going gets tough. It is essentially a chance for the volunteer to experience personal development and for the community to be a part of cultural exchange - anything beyond that is a bonus.

Bob was able to put his language and intercultural skills to work with an international aid organization following his time in Kazakhstan; more philosophically, he wound up with a better picture of the world and his place in it. One of the most quantifiable skills he gained (i.e. this one's for the resume) is the ability to work with people from different backgrounds.

On a more serious note: what about Borat?

Opinions abound, but I give a bit more credibility to someone who lived in Kazakhstan for two years and who can also provide perspective on how a largely American audience will likely perceive the film. In Bob's own words:

I am saddened by it. Most people know next to nothing about Kazakhstan and after they watch the movie they will think it is a backwards place with ignorant people. Nothing could be further from the truth. The country has its share of problems but it also has a 99% literacy rate. The people are warm, compassionate humans who in no way resemble the stumbling fools you see in the movie. I wish Borat would have chosen a fictional place instead of giving a bad name to a country that doesn't deserve it.

Bob's advice for potential Peace Corps Volunteers:

Apply well in advance of when you'd like to leave - it can take from 9 months to 2 years from the date you apply to the date you are placed.

Be armed with 1) a sense of humor so you can take the challenges in stride and perhaps even 2) TEFL training of your own if possible.

Don't expect to save the world - look at the experience as an opportunity to take part in another culture, share your own culture, and grow as a person.

Bring your own hot water heater (okay, that's my attempt at a joke. Bob didn't say that but it's not a bad idea, is it?)
