### **Tales of the imagination**

I've never been a great fan of Richard Rorty. Always seemed a little at the relativistic end of the postmodern spectrum. You know the "Gulf War never happened", "there is no reality only the text" sort of thing. But I've just come across a quote from him that makes me see him slightly differently.

"A society which took his moral vocabulary from novels rather than from ontico-theological or want to ontico-moral treaties would ask itself what we can do so as to get along with each other, how we can arrange things so as to be comfortable with one another, how institutions can be changed so that everyone's right to be understood has a better chance of being gratified." ~Philosophers, Novelists and Intercultural Companions™, Cultural Otherness, ed. A Niyogi Balsev. (1991)

Richard Kearney, Whose wonderful book On Stories is where I found the Rorty quote, says the philosopher is arguing for a society "inspired by narrative imagination rather than doctrinal sermons or abstract treaties."

I may be taking it too far, but this seems to be exactly what the Live Web is setting in motion. By enabling ordinary people, and extraordinary people, to create a whole new set of stories and narratives, we are potentially making centres of power right at the base of our society and culture. By enabling everyone to tell their stories and link them together, we are undermining the power of Big narratives and narrators who previously have wielded sermons, lessons and documentaries.

As we search for new ways of telling stories using multimedia, hypermedia and most excitingly the possibilities of folksonomy, we are doing more than creating content. We are finding new ways to think about ourselves, talk about ourselves, connect with each other, build subjectivities, and write our histories. The talk of citizen journalism is all about new economic models for both and Big Media and small media. But citizens journalism is just the tip of a new narrative/documentary iceberg. The millions of stories spinning around blogs, wikis, podcasts and countless other formats are more than news, they are first and foremost stories which people used to make sense of their lives, their relationships and their communities. I have argued before that the Live Web is not interested in supplanting Big Media. It is happily deconstructing and sidestepping its discourses and practices. Maybe this is a revolution not just in media, not just in narrative, but in society.

The potential is not just interesting new content, new business models, or just "more choice". It is a new way of telling stories and consequently of thinking about ourselves and acting.
