Apparently the owner has had her architect apply for demolition and rebuilding of the House of Obasan. (Please see below.)

Any ideas about what to do?

Six e-mails later that day, Ann-Marie Metten and I had written a press release for re-launching the "Save Kogawa House"

campaign. ; We had contacted important organizations and individuals in the community. ; And the Globe & Mail's Alexandra Gill had committed to an announcement for Saturday's issue. We met in person the following evening at the Asian Canadian Writer's Workshop / Ricepaper Magazine 10th Anniversary dinner, which was honouring Joy Kogawa with a Community Builder's award.

Ann-Marie and I have become friends, working together on the Kogawa House campaign, together with Anton Wagner in Toronto. ; Eight months after the initial e-mail, Kogawa House was purchased by The Land Conservancy of BC and preserved for generations to come.

Wong encourages tolerance and acceptance by blurring the borders between seemingly polar opposites--the Scottish and Chinese cultures

St. Andrew's Day, November 30, 5th generation Chinese-Canadian Todd Wong donned his kilt and sporran to join others of Scots descent to celebrate the patron saint of Scotland. "Toddish McWong," as he is affectionately known, honours Canada's Scottish descent when he raises a toast to St. Andrew, whose bones were carried for protection to the farthest reaches of the world now known as Scotland.

Later in the season, Todd and his Chinese-Canadian family and friends will continue a longstanding tradition of blending cultural traditions in Todd's annual Gung Haggis Fat Choy dinner. Scheduled for the Sunday evening between Robbie Burns Day on January 27 and Chinese New Year, which falls on the second new moon after winter solstice, Todd's dinner brings together musical performances from both Scottish and Asian communities. Wontons and spring rolls made with haggis and other dishes that merge Scottish and Chinese traditional foods fill the 10-course menu. More than 500 people are expected to participate in the 2007 Gung

Haggis dinner on Sunday, January 28....

Fusion or confusion - Issue 7

The world is in such a dangerous state. Can the arts change anything or should we all give up and get into politics?

Convener(s): Judith Knight

Participants: Munira, Nick, Gordon, Morven, Margred, Rob, Federico.

Summary of discussion and conclusions:

We're sleepwalking into disaster -

Why is Tony Blair still in power?

There is a politics of contentment. Easier for the privileged to maintain the status quo. Arts have a substantial state subsidy.

The arts community made no protest about the use of lottery money to bolster the arts in the first place as a replacement of ACE funding... Over the last 12 years no one's stood up for the changes in arts funding and now the possibility that arts money will go to fund the Olympics... .

Are the arts complacent?

If one is funded by the DCMS how radical can you be?

The recent media furore over the Bengal Tiger as a replacement for Guy Fawkes in Tower Hamlets a project to make the Bengali Community in Brick lane more visible in the wake of 7/7. The press response was

terrifying.

What do we want artists to change?

Cultural Policy is much more political but gets little public profile

Little intelligent debate in the media around the intervention of artists into communities.

The Bengal Tiger project opened up fissures in perceptions from some sections of the 'white' community about their traditions being eroded

There is a feeling that things have gone back 5 years in the intercultural/multicultural debate.

There is an assumption that white people have a problem with Muslims.

Not sure about this... However when you celebrate a heightened sense of difference this might be problematical.

What is there in the white community - an identity is not there any more.

Living in a predominantly white community in rural England and introducing culturally diverse arts projects has brought benefits.

Cultural polarity is more urgent in urban settings where communities live cheek by jowl.

However research into cultural /identity in local authorities in Tower Hamlets and Oldham indicates that young white people interact with other cultural communities. There has been a demonisation of them. A middle class view that is patronizing. They often have a contempt towards the working class

But is the change that the arts make too small?

Sometimes its all to do with context

Addressing a subculture/underground scene in a gallery is appropriate whereas the Bengal Tiger project in a gallery would possibly be an inappropriate context.

Maybe the arts would be more effective if they questioned their own role more publically?

Who is here at this event? How many people are 'local'?

The arts need powerful champions.

Making work outside arts environments/buildings is more likely to attract a 'local' audience.

Lots of things happen to make change in localities. The artists sometimes seem on the edge. They often provide a window dressing.

Are artists afraid of addressing real issues, saying the wrong thing being politically incorrect?

There is little real debate between politicians and artists in the UK.

There is a fear of the lack on engagement of young people in the issues of the day.

There was a complacency when we got a labour govt but that's all changed.

It all seems to be about BEING AGAINST what are we FOR?

Maybe we all need to be more assertive about WHAT WE ARE FOR?

What are artists contributing to a public debate. There is much dissatisfaction with the public realm.

Do artists have to align themselves publicly to a political ideology? What happens if the political status quo changes? Do artists realign themselves?

Are your private values also your public values?

You can be socially engaged without going to your community centre. That's an outmoded concept of being engaged.

Some people want to be engaged with local issues and some with more global issues.

The local and the global are more linked now.

Why has there been no big public debate about immigration when it is such a big issue for many people?

Recommendations:

Draft some principles that seek restore an arms length relationship between the funders and artists doing things.

Reclaim and ensure the right to public space so that developers do not privatise 'public space'. Reclaim public space for all the public.
