A case of isolated dorsal midtarsal (Chopart) dislocation resulting from blunt trauma is reported. The mechanism of injury, management, and long-term outcome are discussed. A 45-year-old inebriated man fell from a 4-m height and landed on his feet. He had immediate bilateral foot and back pain. Radiographs showed a burst fracture of the second lumbar vertebra, a left Pott's fracture, and an isolated dorsal dislocation of the right midtarsal (Chopart) joint. No neurovascular deficits or signs of compartment syndrome were noted. The image intensifier showed the unstable midtarsal joint with dorsal translation of the navicular and cuboid from the talus and calcaneum, respectively. Closed reduction of the midtarsal joint was performed with 2 transfixing 3.5-mm AO cortical screws. The right foot was immobilised in a short leg cast for 6 weeks;

screws were removed 14 weeks later. At 76-month follow-up, the patient had returned to work as a construction worker, but still had right midfoot pain on prolonged walking or standing, because of persistent plantar opening up and dorsal ossification of the midtarsal joints and degenerative change at the talonavicular joint. With hindsight, open reduction may have led to a better outcome through repair of the plantar ligamentous structures, especially the plantar calcaneonavicular (spring) ligament.

Youâ€™re reading this on a screen. Maybe itâ€™s your laptop on the kitchen table, or that cheap excuse for a monitor they gave you at work. Maybe youâ€™re one of those rich folks whoâ€™s plopped on your couch,

your feet up on the ottoman, watching this on your 60" Sony Bravia HD set. Whatever your circumstance, you're reading a newspaper " 21st-century style.

It's not the wave of the future any more; it's reality. Newspapers are going electronic.

Me, I'm an old school guy. I still like my papers on paper. I like the crinkling sound. I like cutting out a comic strip when it really tickles me. I get a kick out of my wife grabbing for the food pages when I'm still reading the op-eds. I don't ever mind when I spill some jelly on my paper at breakfast.

Oh, I know I'm on the losing end of the battle to keep things the same. I know that one of these days the Internet, in all of its glory, will do away with good old hands-on newspapers. And I know that if want to stay in this business, I'll stand tall and go with the trend.

I just wasn't ready to come across the tiny, one-paragraph item that was buried deep inside one of those pesky Boston dailies this morning (just a few inches above a story about layoffs at the Philadelphia Inquirer).

It was about Presstek discontinuing its Precision Analog plate business. Translation: A company that was a major player in making the metal plates used in newspaper production is no longer making those plates.

They're going to focus its resources on expanding its digital technology business. So never mind layoffs and shrinking circulation at newspaper companies and in newspaper readerships. Washington, USA (MM): Recognizing that immigrants could provide special assistance to the armed forces as translators, Congress in 2006 passed a law providing for up to 50 immigrant visas per year for translators serving in Iraq and Afghanistan. Given the great need for Arabic, Pashto, Dari, and other translators, it is not clear why Congress chose this low number. Congress has failed to act on the few legislative proposals that would significantly increase the participation of immigrants in the military.

Malaysia: special court appoints translators for illegal immigrant cases

Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia (Bernama): Less than a month after their inception, the special courts on illegal immigrants, set up at detention centres, have settled some 420 cases. The Immigration Department will conduct meetings with several officers from the embassies and high commissions next week to appoint translators for the illegal immigrants. "Except for Indonesia, we have requested several countries to submit at least 10 names that we can give to the court to be appointed as interpreters," he said. He said among the countries with many illegal immigrants here were Pakistan, Bangladesh, Myanmar, Cambodia, Vietnam and China as well as several West Asian nations like Iran and Iraq."

He counts his sacrifice for America in bones and skin. He is missing a finger, an eye and part of his skull, after a large bomb exploded next to his Humvee last year. He has received two threats to his life. Two bodyguards accompany him everywhere. He stays in three different houses to confuse potential attackers.

Interview of Simon Armitage

London, UK (Independent): Simon Armitage's translation [of Sir Gawain and the Green Knight] is, necessarily, an adaptation. Some translators - Tolkien springs to mind - have stuck as close as possible to the original, in structure as well as in diction, thus inadvertently, as Armitage points out, coming out with something "which seemed older than the original". Others have rather ploddingly avoided the challenges of the verse altogether. Others have kept the alliteration but dropped the rhyme. Armitage keeps structure, rhyme and alliteration, but messes about genially with the vocabulary. The result, apart from some forced alliteration, and some truly weird anachronism, is alert, alive and accessible. The lyricism, the power and the drive of the original are triumphantly present.
